O R D E R

On February 22, 2000, the Commission issued an Order directing The Union Light, Heat and Power Company ("ULH&P") to show cause why it was not in violation of Commission regulation 807 KAR 5:027, Section 3(1)(f) and (g). UHL&P filed a response to the Order on March 10, 2000. Although UHL&P did not request an informal conference with Commission Staff pursuant to the show cause Order the Commission, after reviewing the response of UHL&P, finds that an informal conference would be of benefit to Commission Staff and UHL&P. Therefore, upon its own motion, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. The formal hearing set for March 28, 2000 is continued pending further Orders of the Commission.
2. An informal conference shall be held with Commission Staff and UHL&P on March 28, 2000 at 9:30 a.m., Eastern Standard Time, in Conference Room 1 of the Commission's offices at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky.
3. ULH&P shall present evidence concerning the construction and inspection schedule for the relocation of the one-inch valve and box.

4. ULH&P shall bring all documents to support its position and shall be represented by counsel or a corporate officer authorized to enter into any settlement agreement.
