O R D E R

On April 5, 2000, Muhlenberg County Water District No. 3 ("Muhlenberg") applied for authority to establish certain non-recurring charges and revise its tariff policies. Muhlenberg has provided adequate evidence of the individual expenses incurred to provide the services associated with the proposed charges.

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, finds that:

1. The proposed charges are equal to the expenses incurred to provide the associated services.
2. The charges and policies set forth in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The charges in the Appendix are approved for services rendered on and after June 1, 2000.
2. The proposed tariff sheets filed by Muhlenberg are approved as filed.

### APPENDIX TO AN ORDER OF THE KENTUCKY PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION IN CASE NO. 2000-164 DATED APRIL 25, 2000

The following rates, charges, and policies are prescribed for the customers in the area served by Muhlenberg County Water District No. 3. All other rates, charges, and policies not specifically mentioned herein shall remain the same as those in effect under authority of the Commission prior to the effective date of this Order.

#### Special Non-Recurring Charges

Customer Requested Meter Test	\$35.00

Any customer requesting a meter be tested will be charged \$35.00 if the meter tests within the limits set by the Public Service Commission. If the meter tests outside acceptable limits, there will be no charge for the test. There will continue to be no charge for tests done at the discretion of the Water District.
