On September 30, 1991, in Case No. 90-402, the Commission approved certain adjusted rates for Martin Gas, Inc. ("Martin") and provided for their further adjustment when the wholesale cost of gas changes or a refund is received.

On January 4, 2001, Martin filed for approval to pass its increased wholesale gas cost from its suppliers, Clean Gas and Equitable Energy, to its customers effective January 1, 2001. The Commission issued its Order dated February 2, 2001 in which it corrected Martin's proposed gas cost adjustment based on the cost support submitted with the filing. On February 8, 2001, Martin asked for reconsideration of the Commission's decision. Martin stated that it had filed erroneous data in its January 4, 2001 application.

After reviewing the record in this case and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

1. Martin's revised data filed in support of its proposed GCA of \$6.4929 is correct and should be accepted. Martin supplied information that its expected purchases from Equitable Energy will be 10,080 Mcf at a rate of \$14.57 per Mcf.

Correcting for these items, the revised EGC should be \$6.4929, which is \$2.5875 per Mcf more than the previous expected gas supply cost of \$3.9054.

2. The rate adjustment in the Appendix to this Order is fair, just, and reasonable, in the public interest, and should be effective with bills rendered on or after February 3, 2001.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The revised rates proposed by Martin are approved.

2. The rates in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable and are approved effective for gas supplied on and after February 3, 2001.

3. Within 30 days of the date of this Order, Martin shall file with this Commission its revised tariffs setting out the rates authorized in this Order.
