<u>ORDER</u>

In compliance with the Commission's Order of August 31, 2000, Kenergy Corp. ("Kenergy") has submitted a cost-of-service study. Kenergy has also moved to amend its application to include proposed revisions to its special charges, customer classifications, and rules.¹ Having reviewed the motion, the Commission finds that the motion should be granted. We further find that a procedural schedule should be established to permit discovery and a hearing on the proposed rate adjustment as amended.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Kenergy's Motion to Amend Application is granted.

 Kenergy's Amended Application is accepted for filing as of the date of this Order.

Kenergy's requested deviations from Administrative Regulation 807 KAR
5:001, Section 10, are granted.

4. Kenergy shall publish, in accordance with Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(3)(b), the notice of its proposed rate adjustment, once a week

for 3 consecutive weeks in a prominent manner in a newspaper of general circulation in its service area, the first publication to be made within 7 days of the date of this Order.

5. Within 45 days of the date of this Order, Kenergy shall file an affidavit from the publisher verifying that the notice was published, including the dates of the publication, with an attached copy of the published notice.

6. The procedural schedule set forth in the Appendix to this Order shall be followed.

7. Any Commission Staff's interrogatory or request for production of documents shall be responded to as if ordered by the Commission.

8. Kenergy shall give notice of the hearing in accordance with the provisions set out in 807 KAR 5:011, Section 8(5). At the time publication is requested, it shall forward a duplicate of the notice and request to the Commission.

9. At any hearing in this matter, neither opening statements nor summarization of direct testimony shall be permitted.

10. Motions for extensions of time with respect to the schedule herein shall be made in writing and will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

11. All documents filed by any party in the record of this proceeding shall be served upon all parties of record.

12. Service of any document or pleading shall be made in accordance with Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:001, Section 3(7), and Kentucky Civil Rule 5.02.

13. To be timely filed with the Commission, a document must be received by the Secretary of the Commission within the specified time for filing except that any document shall be deemed timely filed if it has been transmitted by United States express mail, or by other recognized mail carriers, with the date the transmitting agency received said document from the sender noted by the transmitting agency on the outside of the container used for transmitting, within the time allowed for filing.
