ORDER

On December 14, 2000, Madison County Utility District ("Madison District") applied to the Commission for (a) a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for the construction of water facilities; (b) approval of the proposed plan of financing said project through the Drinking Water Revolving Fund; and (3) an adjustment of rates. In its filing, Madison District requested permission to deviate from the requirements of Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:001, Section 6.

Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:001, Section 6, requires the submission of a detailed financial exhibit for the period ending not more than 90 days prior to the date of the application. Madison District states that due to an unexpected delay in filing, its test year ended prior to 90 days from the date of filing. It further states that there have been no material changes to the revenues or expenses of the District to affect the validity of the financial information submitted. Having reviewed the filing and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the information filed therein is sufficient to enable the Commission to review adequately Madison District's filing and that good cause has been

shown to grant the requested deviation. Therefore, its request to deviate from the abovecited regulation should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Madison District's request to deviate from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 6, is granted.
