## COMMISSION STAFF'S SECOND INFORMATION REQUEST TO APACHE GAS TRANSMISSION COMPANY, INC.

("Apache Gas") file the original and 5 copies of the following information with the Commission within 14 days of the date of this request, with a copy to all parties of record. Include with each response the name of the witness who will be responsible for responding to questions relating to the information provided. Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure its legibility. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information should be provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations, separately.

- 1. Has Apache Gas taken any legal steps to determine the ownership of the Fort Knox line?
- 2. In response to Commission Staff's data request 1(c), Apache Gas stated that Burkesville Gas Company, Inc. ("Burkesville") has been maintaining the Fort Knox

line "pursuant to a directive of the Public Service Commission in Case No. 90-290."

Provide a copy of that directive or any other authority upon which Apache Gas may rely

for Burkesville's obligation to maintain the Fort Knox line.

3. The 1997 Operation, Maintenance, and Transportation Agreement

between Apache Gas and Burkesville lists 119 Upper River Street, Burkesville,

Kentucky as the address of Apache Gas. This is also the address for Burkesville. Are

the two companies operated out of the same office?

a. If yes, provide how shared costs are allocated between the two

companies, as well as the accounting procedures in place to ensure that each company

pays its own directly attributable expenses.

b. If no, provide the location of the business office of Apache Gas.

4. Provide the names of the employees of Apache Gas.

5. Provide the names of the individuals or entities that provide maintenance

for the transmission lines of Apache Gas.
