O R D E R

Crown Communication Inc. and Powertel/Kentucky, Inc. (“Applicants”) have filed a petition with the Commission requesting a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct and operate a wireless telecommunications facility at 211 Peterson Drive, Elizabethtown, Hardin County, Kentucky.

The Elizabethtown Planning Commission (“Elizabethtown”) has been granted intervention in this proceeding. In an Order dated May 15, 2001, this Commission required Elizabethtown to notify the Commission by no later than May 30, 2001 of its intent to appear at the hearing and present evidence against the construction of the tower. Also, by May 30, 2001, Elizabethtown must notify the Commission in writing of any alternative site that it wishes to be considered. No intervenor may produce evidence at the hearing regarding alternative sites that have not been proposed by May 30, 2001.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. If Elizabethtown intends to appear at the hearing scheduled for June 12, 2001 and present evidence against construction of the tower, it shall file a statement of intent to appear in opposition to the proposed telecommunications facility by no later than May 30, 2001. If no statement is filed by that date, the hearing shall be cancelled and the matter shall be submitted to the Commission on the existing record without further orders herein.

2. Elizabethtown shall not produce evidence at the hearing regarding alternative sites unless those alternative sites have been proposed in writing to this Commission by May 30, 2001.
