O R D E R

On January 16, 2001, Legacy Farm Townhomes ("Legacy Farm") filed a request to continue the hearing scheduled for January 18, 2001. Legacy Farm had previously met with Commission Staff in an informal conference on January 11, 2001.

The Commission stated in the Order initiating this case that any motion for continuance of a hearing set by the Commission shall be made only for good cause and sufficiently in advance of the hearing date to allow time for the Commission to rule upon the motion.

The motion by Legacy Farm states that it has retained a contractor to review its gas system and to perform such maintenance on its system as is necessary to bring it into compliance with the law. Legacy Farm states that, by February 5, 2001, it will have a definitive timetable of the necessary inspections and maintenance of its gas system. Legacy Farm states it is currently modifying its operations and maintenance ("O&M") plan. Legacy Farm requests additional time in which to develop a proposed settlement,

change its O&M plan, and establish a timeframe for cathodic protection to be installed on its system.


The Commission, having considered the motion and grounds therefor, and being sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. The hearing scheduled for February 18, 2001 is continued until further Orders of the Commission.
2. On or before February 15, 2001, Legacy Farm shall file its O&M plan.
3. On or before February 15, 2001, Legacy Farm shall file its timetable for cathodic protection of its gas system.
4. On or before March 1, 2001, Legacy Farm shall submit its settlement proposal.
