## ORDER

North Marshall Water District and McCreary County Water District have moved for extensions of time in which to respond to the Commission's Order of November 2, 2000. Finding that these motions have been rendered moot by the Commission's Order of December 14, 2000, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that these motions are denied.

Kentucky Rural Water Association, Inc. ("KRWA") has moved for an informal conference in this matter to discuss the following issues: the feasibility of filing electronic responses to the Commission's Order of November 2, 2000; the clarification of certain aspects of the Order of November 2, 2000; limitation of the scope of certain requests contained in that Order; and limited immunity to responding utilities from any administrative action that may result from its response to those requests. Having considered this motion and finding that it should be granted, the Commission FURTHER ORDERS that:

- 1. KRWA's motion for an informal conference is granted.
- 2. An informal conference shall be held in this matter on January 17, 2001 at 1:00 p.m., Eastern Standard Time, in Hearing Room 2 of the Commission's offices at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky.

3. KRWA shall file with the Commission no later than January 12, 2001 a

written list of all requests set forth in Appendix B of the Commission's Order of

November 2, 2000, for which it seeks clarification.

4. KRWA shall file with the Commission no later than January 12, 2001 a

written list of all requests set forth in Appendix B of the Commission's Order of

November 2, 2000, for which it seeks to narrow the scope of such request.

5. Any other party to this proceeding who wishes to present additional issues

for discussion shall file with the Commission, no later than January 12, 2001, a written

list of those issues.

6. The Executive Director shall take all actions necessary to broadcast the

proceedings of this informal conference over the Commission's Internet site

(www.psc.ky.state.us).
