## <u>ORDER</u>

Crown Communication Inc. and Kentucky CGSA, LLC ("Applicants") have filed an application requesting a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct and operate a wireless telecommunications facility at 3690 Bryan Station Road, Lexington, Kentucky 40522. The Commission has scheduled a hearing for September 18, 2001. On July 16, 2001, the Applicants filed a notice that they have agreed to an extension of the deadline to October 22, 2001 for the local planning unit to advise the Applicants and the Commission of the planning unit's final decision. Accompanying this notice was a motion to modify the public hearing date. Applicants request that the Commission reschedule the hearing to a date after October 22, 2001. This is the only requested change to the procedural schedule.

Accordingly, IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The September 18, 2001 hearing on the proposed wireless telecommunications facility is rescheduled to November 8, 2001, at 9:00 a.m., Eastern

Standard Time, in Hearing Room 1 of the Commission's offices at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky.

2. All aspects of the June 18, 2001 Order, except for the hearing date, remain in full force and effect.
