<u>ORDER</u>

On April 26, 2001, the Commission issued an Order in this proceeding establishing a procedural schedule. On May 4, 2001, AT&T Communications of the South Central States, Inc. ("AT&T") filed a motion to revise this procedural schedule, asserting that the Commission's schedule provides for insufficient review of the first and second filings by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"). The Commission finds that AT&T's motion is reasonable and should be granted. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Parties shall file responses within 20 days from the filing of BellSouth's first submittal regarding compliance with specific checklist items.

2. Parties shall file responses within 30 days from the filing of BellSouth's second submittal regarding the basis of proof of Section 271 compliance. This filing shall include particular statements of dispute with BellSouth's assertions.
