## <u>O R D E R</u>

On June 25, 2001, the Bellevue Planning and Zoning Commission ("Bellevue") sought intervention in this proceeding. However, Case No. 2001-157-UAC, referenced in the request, is the inappropriate case number to use when referring to the location of a cellular tower at 650 Colfax Avenue, Bellevue, Kentucky. This site has been docketed as Case No. 2001-156-UAC.

Appropriate written request having been made by Thomas J. Eigel on behalf of Bellevue, 616 Poplar Street, Bellevue, Kentucky 41073 to fully intervene herein, it appearing to the Commission that the full intervention of Bellevue is likely to present issues and develop facts that will assist the Commission in considering this matter without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings, and the Commission being otherwise sufficiently advised, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The request of Bellevue to fully intervene is granted.

2. Bellevue shall be entitled to the full rights of a party and shall be served with the Commission's Orders and with filed testimony, exhibits, pleadings, correspondence, and all other documents submitted by the parties after the date of this Order.

3. Should any Intervenor file documents of any kind with the Commission in the course of these proceedings, a copy of said documents shall also be served upon all other parties of record.
