O R D E R

On June 27, 2001, Northern Kentucky Water District (“Northern Kentucky”) applied to the Commission for authority to issue certain securities. On September 10, 2001, Northern Kentucky filed a motion to hold this case in abeyance for 30 days. As grounds, Northern Kentucky states that this additional time will allow it to “determine the most advantageous manner to refinance these bonds.”


Having reviewed the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. Northern Kentucky’s motion to hold this case in abeyance is granted. This case shall be held in abeyance for 30 days from the date of this Order.
2. Within 30 days of the date of this Order, Northern Kentucky shall file a notice with the Commission stating whether it intends to proceed with the filed application or amend the filed application.
3. If Northern Kentucky fails to file a notice of intent to proceed or an amended application within 30 days of the date of this Order, this case shall be dismissed from the Commission’s active docket without further Order.
