ORDER

Pursuant to Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:056, the Commission on December 20, 2001, established this case to review and evaluate the operation of the fuel adjustment clause (FAC) of South Kentucky Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation (South Kentucky) for the six months ended October 31, 2001.

As part of this review, the Commission ordered South Kentucky to submit certain information concerning its compliance with Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:056. South Kentucky has complied with this Order. The Commission further ordered that a public hearing be held in this case but cancelled it when, after publication of notice, no interested party advised the Commission of its intention to attend.


The Commission, having considered the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds no evidence that South Kentucky has improperly calculated or applied its FAC charge.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the charges and credits applied by South Kentucky through the FAC for the period May 1, 2001 through October 31, 2001 are approved.
