## **COMMISSION STAFF DATA REQUEST**

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (BellSouth) and Intervenors are to file with the Commission the following information, with a copy to all parties of record. The information requested herein is due on or before March 6, 2002.

1. A narrative description by BellSouth of each of the five areas which it identified to the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) as items of concern leading to the withdrawal of its Section 271 Application for Georgia and Louisiana. BellSouth has refiled the application with the FCC having addressed the five areas. Commission Staff seeks a narrative description of each area as it relates to BellSouth's compliance with 47 U.S.C. § 271 in Kentucky. The five items are: (1) the timeliness of evidence demonstrating that competing carriers could integrate or have successfully integrated pre-ordering and ordering functionality; (2) BellSouth's performance on service order accuracy; (3) the accuracy of certain performance data; (4) the timeliness of evidence of the double FOC performance issue related to the due date calculator;

and (5) the timeliness of evidence related to the allocation of resources in the Change

Control Process.1

2. Intervenors are to submit copies of their reply comments filed with the

FCC in BellSouth's pending application for interLATA entry. These comments are due

at the FCC on March 4, 2002. In addition, Intervenors are to submit comments

regarding the impact of the modifications on Kentucky.
