O R D E R

On February 21, 2002, Webster County Water District ("Webster") filed with the Commission revisions to its tariff proposing to implement a Self-Read Meter Reading Policy (policy) on a trial basis for a 12-month period following Commission approval.

The Commission finds that further proceedings are necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the proposed policy. Webster did not state a date upon which the proposal would become effective. Accordingly, the proposed policy shall not become effective pending final action by the Commission.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this proceeding is established to investigate the reasonableness of Webster s proposed policy.
