O R D E R

On July 29, 2002, Interstate Gas Supply, Inc. (IGS) filed its Protest and Comments regarding Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc.s (Columbia) proposal for mandatory assignment of capacity to the marketers participating in its Customer Choice program. Neither IGS nor the other intervenor, the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, filed testimony in this case. In order to allow the Commission and Columbia an opportunity to fully develop the facts presented in IGS s comments, the Commission finds that the procedural schedule as established by the Commission on April 30, 2002 should be extended.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The procedural schedule set forth in Appendix A, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, shall be followed and supersedes the previous schedules established by the Commission in its Order of April 20, 2002.
2. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering further Orders in this matter.
