O R D E R

On May 21, 2002, the Commission ordered the non-dominant telecommunications providers whose names appeared in an appendix to the Order to show cause within 30 days why they should not be penalized pursuant to KRS 278.990(3) for failure to comply with KRS 278.130 through KRS 278.150. The Order, which arose from the companies failures to pay their annual assessments for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002, notified the companies that, if they failed to appear, their authority to provide service in this state would be revoked, their tariffs would be removed from Commission files, and their names would be stricken from the Commission s list of active utilities.

Since the Order was issued, the companies listed in the Appendix to this Order have either appeared and satisfied the Commission that they should not be penalized as set forth in the Order, or they have paid their delinquent assessments and settled the penalty claims against them. The 30-day period has now expired and, in accordance with the terms of the May 21, 2002 Order, the remaining companies are hereby notified that they are no longer authorized to provide service in this state.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The companies listed in the Appendix to this Order are hereby dismissed from this proceeding.

2. Each company whose authority to operate has been revoked shall immediately cease providing service in this state and notify its customers affected by the Order that they must obtain service from another carrier.

3. Each company whose authority to operate has been revoked may re-apply for authority to serve customers in this state upon payment of the assessments owed plus the statutory penalty of \$1,000 and \$25 per day for each day the payment is overdue.

4. Failure by any provider to comply with this Order will subject the company, its officers, agents, or employees to the penalties prescribed in KRS 278.990(1) and KRS 278.990(3).
