## ORDER

Pursuant to Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:056, the Commission on June 27, 2002 established this case to review and evaluate the operation of the fuel adjustment clause (FAC) of East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. (East Kentucky) for the 6 months ended April 30, 2002.

As part of this review, East Kentucky, pursuant to Commission Order, submitted certain information concerning its compliance with Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:056. A public hearing was held on August 29, 2002.

The Commission has previously established East Kentucky's base fuel cost at 13.29 mills per Kwh. A review of East Kentucky's monthly fuel clause filings shows that the actual fuel cost incurred for the 6-month period under review ranged from a low of 14.84 mills in both February 2002 and April 2002 to a high of 15.54 mills in November 2001, with a 6-month average of 15.10 mills.

Kentucky s FAC charges or improper fuel procurement practices.

Kentucky through its FAC for the period November 1, 2001 to April 30, 2002 are

approved.
