## ORDER

This matter arising upon motion of Glen Mills ( Petitioner ) filed August 14, 2002 for full intervention, and it appearing to the Commission that:

- The application in this case, which was made pursuant to KRS 278.023,
  was filed by Knox County Utility Commission ( Applicant ) on July 31, 2002.
- 2. KRS 278.023 requires the Commission to accept agreements between water utilities and the U.S. Department of Agriculture or the U.S Department of Housing and Urban Development, and to issue the necessary Orders to implement the terms of such agreements within 30 days of satisfactory completion of the minimum filing requirements. Therefore, unless the application does not satisfy the minimum filing requirements established by the Commission in its administrative regulations, the Commission must issue its Order approving by August 30, 2002.
- 3. Petitioner is a customer of Applicant, and therefore clearly has an interest in the proceeding. However, as the Commission may not provide any process to an intervenor in this proceeding due to the provisions of KRS 278.063, the motion to

intervene should be denied. Nevertheless, Petitioner's name should be added to the service list in this matter and served with a copy of the final Order in this case.

The Commission, being otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that:

- 1. The motion of Petitioner to intervene is denied.
- 2. The Petitioner's name is hereby added to the service list for this proceeding and shall be served with a copy of the final Order.
