ORDER

On October 18, 2002, Louisville Gas and Electric Company and Kentucky Utilities Company (Applicants) moved the Commission to enter an Order incorporating, by reference only, the entire record of Case No. 2002-00367¹ into this proceeding. The Commission, having considered the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that the motion should be granted. The Commission further finds that a procedural schedule should be established for this proceeding.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The entire record of Case No. 2002-00367 is incorporated herein by reference.
2. The procedural schedule set forth in Appendix A to this Order shall be followed in this proceeding.
3. The Applicants and all intervenors shall file the information requested by Commission Staff by the dates set forth in Appendix A.

4. Any party filing testimony shall file an original and eight copies. The original and at least three copies of the testimony shall be filed as follows:

- a. Together with cover letter listing each person presenting testimony.
- b. Bound in 3-ring binders or with any other fastener which readily opens and closes to facilitate easy copying.
- c. Each witness s testimony should be tabbed.
- d. Every exhibit to each witness s testimony should be appropriately marked.

5. All requests for information and responses thereto shall be appropriately indexed. All responses shall include the name of the witness who will be responsible for responding to questions related to the information, with copies to all parties of record and an original and six copies to the Commission.

6. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering further Orders in this matter.

7. Motions for extensions of time with respect to the schedule herein shall be made in writing and will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.
