O R D E R

On December 16, 2002, the Commission entered an Order in this matter approving revised Demand-Side Management Cost Recovery Component (DSMRC) tariffs and charges for Louisville Gas and Electric Company (LG&E) and Kentucky Utilities Company (KU). Our Order, however, incorrectly stated that the changes in the tariffs and charges were applicable to service rendered on and after January 1, 2003. The Order should have stated that the changes were effective January 1, 2003. This will allow LG&E and KU to begin billing the approved charges January 1, 2003, without the need to prorate usage for different rate periods.

The Commission THEREFORE ORDERS, nunc pro tunc, that:

1. The last sentence in the first paragraph of the Order of December 16, 2002 should be restated to read: The proposed changes will be applicable to LG&E s gas and electric rates and KU s electric rates for the 12-month period beginning January 1, 2003.

2. The last sentence in the third paragraph of the Order of December 16, 2002 should be restated to read Based on a review of the revised DSMRC tariffs and supporting schedules that show the calculation of the cost recovery, revenues from lost

sales, and incentive sub-parts thereof, the Commission finds that the proposed rate changes are reasonable and should be approved effective January 1, 2003.

3. Ordering Paragraph No. 1 should be restated to read: LG&E s and KU s proposed changes to their DSMRC tariffs are approved effective January 1, 2003.
