On December 18, 2002, Metro Human Needs Alliance and People Organized and Working for Energy Reform (MHNA/POWER) filed a motion requesting revisions to the procedural schedule to provide for sur-rebuttal testimony, a hearing date, and a briefing schedule. The motion alleges that the rebuttal testimony filed by Louisville Gas and Electric Company (LG&E) raises issues not previously presented, proposes a substantial expansion of the prepaid service, and presents a detailed cost/benefit analysis. Kentucky Association for Community Action and Community Action Council for Lexington-Fayette, Bourbon, Harrison and Nicholas Counties filed a response in support of the motion, while LG&E filed a response in opposition. MHNA/POWER also filed a reply to LG&E s response.

Based on a review of the motion and the other pleadings, the Commission finds that LG&E has submitted the testimony of a new witness on rebuttal, and that witness presents for the first time a detailed cost/benefit analysis of the prepaid meter program. Under these circumstances, the intervenors should be afforded an opportunity to conduct additional discovery on the LG&E rebuttal testimony and to submit sur-rebuttal testimony. In recognition that LG&E bears the burden of proof in this proceeding, it should also be afforded an opportunity to respond to any intervenor's sur-rebuttal testimony. Although the Commission had previously scheduled a hearing in this case for January 28, 2003, that date will now need to be changed due to the revisions to the procedural schedule set forth herein. In addition, a briefing schedule will be included in a future Commission Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

The motion of MHNA/POWER to revise the procedural schedule to allow 1. for the filing of sur-rebuttal testimony is granted.

2. The public hearing previously scheduled on January 28, 2003 is cancelled, to be rescheduled by further Order of the Commission.

3. A briefing schedule shall be established by a future Commission Order.

4. The procedural schedule set forth in Appendix A, attached hereto and incorporated herein, shall be followed in this case.
