## <u>O R D E R</u>

On July 10, 2002, the Commission placed this matter on its docket to investigate a proposed revision by Mount Sterling Water and Sewer System (Mount Sterling) of its Water Purchase Contract with Reid Village Water District (Reid Village).

Pursuant to Commission Staff's request, both parties appeared for an informal conference on October 23, 2002. At that conference the parties agreed that further discussion could lead to a settlement of the matter. The Commission found that, as settlement negotiations were being conducted in good faith, the parties should be given sufficient time in which to negotiate a settlement. On July 3, 2003, Mount Sterling filed a letter indicating that it wished to drop the request for a revision of the contract with Reid Village. The Commission will treat the letter as a motion to dismiss the case and to continue the *status quo* of the contract.

The Commission, having been sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that this case is dismissed and is removed from the Commission's docket.
