1. Refer to the response to Item 3 of Commission Staff's data request dated December 23, 2002.

a. Lockwood Estates 2001 annual report reported gross utility plant of \$109,412 and accumulated depreciation of \$88,270. How was the \$66,506 recorded as assets in the journal entry calculated?

b. The journal entry recorded a Miscellaneous Payable of \$66,505.To whom is this liability owed?

2. Provide the December 31, 2002 plant and accumulated depreciation balances for the utility plant to be transferred.

3. Refer to the response to Item 5 of Commission Staff's data request. The response states that revenues from the plants are projected to be sufficient for the operation and maintenance of the facilities in a fiscally appropriate manner. Provide a copy of the projections referred to in the response.
