ORDER

This matter arises upon the motions of the Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc. (KIUC), filed December 20, 2002, for full intervention in the above proceedings. It appears to the Commission that such interventions are likely to present issues and develop facts that will assist the Commission in fully considering the matters without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings. The Commission also recognizes that procedural schedules were established in these proceedings by Orders dated December 13, 2002. The procedural schedules were subsequently revised by Orders dated December 23, 2002. The Commission, being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that KIUC should be granted full rights of a party in these proceedings and should accept the procedural schedules as they now stand.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The motions of KIUC to intervene are granted, and KIUC shall accept the existing procedural schedules.

2. KIUC shall be entitled to the full rights of a party and shall be served with the Commission's Orders and with filed testimony, exhibits, pleadings, correspondence, and all other documents submitted by parties after the date of this Order.

3. Should KIUC file documents of any kind with the Commission in the course of these proceedings, it shall also serve a copy of said documents on all other parties of record.
