O R D E R

On May 6, 2004, AT&T Communications of the South Central States, LLC ("AT&T") moved to amend the April 16, 2004 procedural schedule. In support of its motion, AT&T states that additional time is needed to obtain information which Kentucky ALLTEL, Inc. ("ALLTEL") considers confidential. ALLTEL and AT&T are only now entering a protective agreement whereby AT&T may receive a copy of all of the confidential material. AT&T asserts that review of ALLTEL's cost model and related exhibits is necessary for it to meaningfully participate in this case. AT&T requests a two-week extension of time to permit it to receive the confidential material and to complete a data request. ALLTEL does not oppose the extension.

The Commission, having been sufficiently advised and finding good cause for the requested extension, HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. By May 21, 2004, intervenors may file data requests for ALLTEL.
2. By June 11, 2004, ALLTEL shall file responses to data requests submitted on May 21, 2004.
3. By June 25, 2004, any party to this proceeding shall file comments on ALLTEL's filings.

4. By July 9, 2004, any party, including ALLTEL, that desires a public hearing in this matter shall file a written request for a hearing. If no such request is received, this matter will stand submitted for Commission decision.

5. Motions for extensions of time with respect to this revised schedule shall be made in writing and will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.
