O R D E R

We reopen this case for the purpose of considering the petition of Go Solo Technologies, Inc. (“Go Solo”) for reinstatement of its authority to provide telecommunications services in Kentucky. The tariff of Go Solo, a long-distance telecommunications company, was removed from the Commission’s files and its name stricken from the Commission’s list of active telecommunications companies for failure to file its 2002 annual assessments.

In its petition, Go Solo states that it had unintentionally neglected its responsibilities for regulatory compliance during a corporate reorganization. It acknowledges that it received adequate warning from the Commission prior to its loss of authorization. It also states that it currently has an agreement with Telecom Compliance Services, Inc. to assist it with ongoing compliance with state requirements. It apologizes for its previous failure to comply with Kentucky law and states that it will meet all future obligations in a timely manner. It also offers the Commission \$500 in settlement of all penalties or fines resulting from its failure to comply, and has enclosed a check in that amount with its petition.

This Commission takes seriously any failure on the part of a regulated utility to comply with Kentucky law. However, Go Solo's proffered offer of settlement, its arrangements to ensure that future regulatory compliance is assured, and its acknowledgment of the seriousness of its previous failures demonstrate that it is prepared to comply with Kentucky law.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Go Solo's offer of settlement is accepted as payment in full of all obligations and penalties relating to service provided in Kentucky prior to August 21, 2002.
2. Go Solo is authorized to provide service in Kentucky on and after the effective date of its tariff.
3. This case is closed and is removed from the Commission's docket.
