O R D E R

On April 29, 2004, the Commission found that the proposal for a resolution of third party transit traffic issues associated with Commercial Mobile Radio Service providers and independent telephone companies submitted by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. appeared reasonable. The compensation arrangements contained in the proposal were ordered to be placed into effect on an interim basis pending resolution of any issues that may affect parties who were not signatories to the agreement. By that same Order, the Commission established a procedural schedule "in order to conclude this proceeding." The Order scheduled a hearing, but provided that if no party requested the public hearing, it would be canceled. No party requested the hearing. Moreover, the Commission has not received any objections to the compensation arrangement proposal from any parties who are not signatories to the arrangement.

The Commission THEREFORE ORDERS that the proposal placed into effect on an interim basis subject to refund and adjustment on April 29, 2004 is approved on a permanent basis, and this case is hereby removed from the Commission's docket.
