On January 22, 2004, pursuant to the request of Doe Valley Utilities, Inc. ("Doe Valley"), the formal hearing in this matter was continued and the established procedural schedule was suspended. On February 6, 2004, an informal conference was held pursuant to an Order of the Commission. At the informal conference it was agreed among the parties that Doe Valley Home Owners Association, Inc. ("Home Owners") should be made a party to these proceedings and that the procedural schedule should be amended to clarify the issues before this Commission, to allow the filing of additional evidence, and to allow for other procedural matters.

The Commission finds that the Home Owners should be made a party to these proceedings and that the procedural schedule should be amended.

The Commission, having considered the record herein and being sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. Home Owners shall be a party to these proceedings.

2. The procedural schedule is amended as follows:

On or before February 27, 2004, Doe Valley shall file any motion to a. submit the matter to the Commission for a decision, together with any additional testimony or evidence in support of said motion, and any request for a formal hearing.

b. On or before March 12, 2004, any party may file a response to the filing of Doe Valley, or a request for a formal hearing.

3. If any party requests a formal hearing, that party shall specifically identify the issues to be heard and state briefly the testimony it intends to present at the hearing.

4. If no request for a formal hearing is filed according to the amended procedural schedule, this matter shall be submitted to the Commission for a decision upon the existing record without further Order.
