ORDER

On May 18, 2004, the city of Lawrenceburg ("Lawrenceburg") filed a status report and motion for enlargement of time of 30 days to tender the executed contract with the South Anderson Water District ("South Anderson District"). The motion stated that a proposed water purchase contract, setting out the terms negotiated with South Anderson District, has been forwarded for the review of, and a discussion with, the Commissioners of South Anderson District at a meeting of the District's Commissioners on May 20, 2004.

Having considered the motion, the Commission finds that the 30-day extension should be granted and that the executed contract shall be tendered on or before June 17, 2004. If the executed contract is not submitted by the due date, the Commission will initiate a procedural schedule to allow completion of the case by July 17, 2004, which is the end of the 10-month statutory period. The initial step in the procedural schedule will be for the Commission and all parties to deliver initial data requests to Lawrenceburg on or before June 24, 2004, with responses to the data requests to be submitted by Lawrenceburg no later than July 2, 2004. Further Orders will be issued subsequent to

June 17, 2004, or an earlier date if necessary, with further details of the process to be followed to complete the Commission review of this case.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The date for submitting the executed contract is hereby extended for 30 days to on or before June 17, 2004.

2. If the executed contract is not submitted, Lawrenceburg shall submit a full status report including the reasons the executed contract cannot be submitted and a new timetable for submitting the executed contract.

3. If the executed contract is not submitted by June 17, 2004, all parties shall deliver their initial data requests to Lawrenceburg on or before June 24, 2004. All responses to data requests submitted to Lawrenceburg must be provided to the Commission and all parties of record no later than July 2, 2004.
