O R D E R

On March 12, 2004, Cingular Wireless-Kentucky (“Cingular”) filed a motion with the Commission requesting that the procedural schedule be suspended and that an informal conference be scheduled. In support of its motion, Cingular claims that it has admitted incorrectly terminating Complainant’s wireless service and that the Commission has no jurisdiction over Complainant’s other claims. The Commission finds that good cause exists to grant Cingular’s motion.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The procedural schedule established in the Commission’s February 24, 2004 Order is hereby suspended.
2. All parties shall appear for an informal conference on March 30, 2004 at 9:00 a.m., Eastern Standard Time, in Conference Room 1 of the Commission’s offices at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky.
