

3. ULH&P's notice sets out no current refund adjustment ("RA"). The total RA of .4 cent per Mcf represents no change from the previous total RA.

4. ULH&P's notice sets out no current quarter actual adjustment ("AA"). The total AA of 52.2 cents per Mcf represents no change from the previous total AA.

5. ULH&P's notice sets out no current balancing adjustment ("BA"). The total BA of 1.9 cents per Mcf represents no change from the previous total BA.

6. ULH&P's gas cost recovery rate ("GCR") is \$7.095 per Mcf, which is 70.3 cents per Mcf less than its previous GCR of \$7.798.

7. The rates in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable, and should be approved for final meter readings by ULH&P on and after February 2, 2004.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:


1. The rates in the Appendix to this Order are approved for final meter readings on and after February 2, 2004.
