The information requested herein is due no later than 10 days from the date of this request. When a number of sheets are required for an item, each sheet should be appropriately indexed, for example, Item 1(a), Sheet 2 of 6. Include with each response the name of the person who will be responsible for responding to questions relating to the information provided. Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. Where information herein has been previously provided, in the format requested herein, reference may be made to the specific location of said information in responding to this information request.

1. Refer to Exhibit A of the Application. State whether service lines are included in the projects listed.

2. Provide the total footage and the estimated cost of service lines that ULH&P is proposing to replace in 2004.

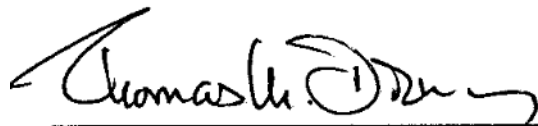
3. Pursuant to Exhibit A of the Application, ULH&P is proposing to replace 109,446 feet of facilities in 2004.

a. State what percentage of the total footage is (i) cast iron, (ii) bare steel, and (iii) plastic.

b. State what percentage of the total footage involves insertion.

c. State what percentage of the total footage involves excavation.

4. For all projects that involve excavation, provide the total cost of removal.
