O R D E R

The Commission has reviewed the responses of BTU Gas Company (“BTU”) to our Order of February 23, 2004, and finds that BTU’s Response to Requests 1 and 2 are non-responsive. The condensed map filed by BTU in its response to Request 1 does not include BTU’s distribution mains or service connections as requested, nor is there a map filed in this case indicating BTU’s distribution system.

At Request 2, we directed BTU to supply the date upon which each listed customer was connected to the BTU system. In its response BTU states that all individuals on the list in the Dixie section have been BTU customers since 1994 and has attached as Appendix 2 customer ledger cards containing six names with a year date no earlier than 2000. It states that it already had mains in this area and lists the size, length and cost of these mains. The mains and the construction as listed by BTU should be noted on the map as required by Request 1. The date of each listed construction should also have been furnished.

Accordingly, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS AND COMPELS BTU to file within 7 days of the date of this Order:

1. A map of BTU's distribution system specifically showing BTU's distribution mains and the construction listed in its response to Request 2(b), with the dates of said construction.

2. A list of the Dixie section customers and the specific dates that each was connected to BTU's system.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the formal hearing in this matter, set for April 6, 2004, is continued generally.
