O R D E R

On February 9, 2004, the Commission ordered Jackson Purchase Energy Corporation (“Jackson Purchase”) to respond to the complaint filed by Ballard Rural Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Inc. on February 2, 2004. On February 19, 2004, Jackson Purchase filed a motion for an extension of time to and including March 9, 2004 to respond. Jackson Purchase states in support of its motion that, due to the complicated nature of the case, its counsel needs additional time to gather the information necessary for response.

Having considered the motion, the Commission finds that good cause has been shown to grant the motion.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The motion for extension of time is granted.

2. Jackson Purchase shall have to and including March 9, 2004 to satisfy the matters complained of or to file a written answer to the complaint.
