## ORDER

On May 14, 2004, the Attorney General, by and through his Office of Rate Intervention ("AG"), filed a motion to change the hearing date as established in the Commission's May 10, 2004 Order. The AG notes that the public hearing is scheduled to begin on August 17, 2004, and is expected to take two days to complete. The AG states that he will have difficulty producing one of his witnesses at the public hearing as scheduled, but will be able to produce the witness if the start of the hearing is delayed one day, to August 18, 2004.

In his motion, the AG states that he has consulted with Delta Natural Gas Company, Inc. ("Delta") and that Delta authorized him to advise the Commission that the request is acceptable to Delta. The AG did not indicate whether he had contacted the other intervenor, the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government; however, no comments on the AG's motion have been received from that party.

Having considered the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that good cause has been shown to grant the motion and to amend the procedural schedule established by the Commission on May 10, 2004.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- The public hearing in this case will begin on August 18, 2004, at 9:00 a.m.,
   Eastern Daylight Time, in Hearing Room 1 at the Commission's offices at 211 Sower
   Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky.
- 2. All other dates as set forth in the May 10, 2004 procedural schedule shall remain unchanged.
