ORDER

On April 1, 2004, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth") provided written notice to the Commission of its intent to disconnect Teleconex, Inc. ("Teleconex") for nonpayment of bills. BellSouth asserts the unpaid amount is \$260,741.65, of which \$11,930.77 is for services provided in Kentucky. BellSouth plans to discontinue services to Teleconex if payments are not received. Disconnection of Teleconex services will impact 243 Kentucky customers.

BellSouth requests authorization to invoke the Emergency Service Continuity Tariff approved by this Commission on May 20, 2003 in Case No. 2002-00310. Invoking this tariff is necessary only if Teleconex has not notified its end-users of the service disconnection. If the Emergency Service Continuity Tariff is invoked, BellSouth will continue to provide telephone service to Teleconex's customers for a minimum of 14 days after Teleconex ceases to operate.

The Commission, having reviewed BellSouth's notice and having been otherwise

sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. Teleconex shall notify the Commission within 7 calendar days of the date

of this Order of its intent to pay the delinquent bill to BellSouth by April 10, 2004, or, in

the alternative, of its intent to notify its end-users of the proposed service disconnection.

Such written comments shall include a copy of Teleconex's customer notice and an

affidavit indicating when the notice was mailed and the number of Kentucky customers

to whom it was mailed.

2. A copy of BellSouth's notice of intent to disconnect Teleconex is attached

hereto and incorporated herein.

3. If Teleconex has not responded as prescribed in Ordering Paragraph 1

within 7 calendar days of the date of this Order, BellSouth shall implement the

procedures established in its Emergency Service Continuity Tariff.

4. A copy of this Order shall be sent by certified mail to Teleconex.
