On September 16, 2004, Jackson Purchase Energy Corporation ("Jackson Purchase") submitted an application pursuant to 807 KAR 5:011 seeking authority to increase its cable television ("CATV") attachment rates. Since Jackson Purchase was seeking an adjustment for a recurring rate, the application was required to be filed pursuant to the general rate application requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10. Finding that these requirements had not been met, the application was rejected on October 26, 2004. On November 15, 2004, Jackson Purchase tendered a new application and requested therein that it be permitted to deviate from several of the general rate application requirements. Jackson Purchase states in support of its request to deviate that its filing meets all the requirements necessary for the Commission's consideration and approval of the proposed adjustment to its CATV rates.

The Commission, having considered the application and the request for deviations, finds good cause to grant waivers to the following filing requirements under 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10: (6)(g)--Billing Analysis; (6)(h)--Summary Determination of

Revenue Requirements; (6)(i)--Reconciliation of Rate Base and Capital; (6)(j)--Current Chart of Accounts; (6)(k)--Independent Auditor's Annual Report; (6)(I)--FERC or FCC Audit Reports; (6)(m)--FERC Form; (6)(n)--Summary of Latest Depreciation Study; (6)(p)--Prospectus of Stock and Bond Offerings; (6)(q)--Annual Report to Members; (6)(r)--Monthly Managerial Reports; (6)(s)--SEC's Annual Report; (6)(t)--Details of Affiliate Allocated Charges; (6)(u)--Cost-of-Service Studies; (7)(b)--Capital Construction Budget; (7)(c)--Amount of Construction Work in Progress; (7)(d)--Monthly Operating Budgets; and (7)(e)--Test Year Customer Growth and Revenue Impact.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Jackson Purchase is granted permission to deviate from the filing requirements enumerated herein.
