## <u>O R D E R</u>

This matter arises upon the motion of Southern Madison Water District ("Southern Madison"), filed October 11, 2004, for full intervention. On October 14, 2004, the Joint Applicants in this case filed a response to Southern Madison's motion stating no objection to the motion so long as the proceeding is not delayed. It appears to the Commission that Southern Madison is likely to present issues and develop facts that will assist the Commission in fully considering the matter without unduly complicating the proceedings. The Commission also recognizes that a procedural schedule was established in this proceeding by Order dated October 12, 2004.

The Commission, being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that Southern Madison should be granted the full rights of a party in this proceeding and should be required to accept the procedural schedule as it now stands.

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

 The motion of Southern Madison to intervene is granted, and Southern Madison shall accept the existing procedural schedule. 2. Southern Madison shall be entitled to the full rights of a party and shall be served with the Commission's Orders and with filed testimony, exhibits, pleadings, correspondence, and all other documents submitted by parties after the date of this

Order.

3. Should Southern Madison file documents of any kind with the Commission

in the course of these proceedings, it shall also serve a copy of said documents on all

other parties of record.
