O R D E R

Between November 15, 2004 and November 24, 2004, the above-named Complainants filed against Louisville Gas and Electric Company and Kentucky Utilities Company ("LG&E/KU") three separate formal complaints. On December 6, 2004, LG&E filed a motion requesting that the above-captioned cases be held in abeyance and that the Commission schedule an informal conference to discuss LG&E's policies regarding

terms and conditions of service. LG&E claims that the conference will “serve to resolve the above listed Cases as well as potential new complaints involving similar policies.”¹

The Commission denies LG&E/KU's motion for an informal conference and finds that LG&E/KU should satisfy or answer the matters contained in the complaints. Upon receipt of either the answers or notices of satisfaction to the complaints listed above, the Commission will reconsider LG&E/KU's motion for an informal conference.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. LG&E/KU's motion to schedule an informal conference and to hold the complaints in abeyance is denied.
2. Within 3 days of the date of this Order, LG&E/KU shall file its responses to the complaints listed above.
