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<u>ORDER</u>

On March 29, 2004, the Commission issued an Order which stated, among other things, that a review of the August 14, 2003 blackout was underway and that a consultant had been retained to analyze Kentucky's electric transmission system. The Order further stated that, until the transmission analysis was completed, no findings would be made with respect to Kentucky's transmission system. That transmission analysis, known as a vulnerability assessment, was filed in the record of the Commission's more recent review of Kentucky's electric facilities, Case No. 2005-00090,¹ and was reviewed therein. Consequently, the Commission finds that this case should be closed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. This case is closed and is removed from the Commission's docket.

2. All updated information that is currently required to be filed periodically in this case shall be filed annually as a supplement to the filer's annual report.
