Business address is North American 15 Α. 16 Stainless, 6470 Highway 42 East. 17 All right, sir. I take it you are 0. 18 employed by North American Stainless. That is correct. 19 Α. And what is your -- what are your job 2.0 duties at North American Stainless? 21 Currently the maintenance manager. 22 Α. All right, sir. How long have you 23 Q. been maintenance manager at North American Stainless? 24 About -- about six months now, but 25 Α.

I've been maintenance related and new installation 1 related for a long time. 2 How long have you worked at North 3 Q٠ American Stainless at the Ghent, Kentucky facility? 4 Since 1996. 5 All right, sir. I want to take you 6 ο. back to last year -- well, actually, let's go back to 7 the fall of 2003, and let's call it September 1st, 8 What -- what were your job duties at North 2003. 9 American Stainless as of that point in time? 10 Well, I was coordinating maintenance 11 Α. and new installation work and -- related with all the 12 electrical projects and -- and -- yeah, the matters 1.3 related to our electricity supply fall under my 14 responsibilities. 15 Would the relationship with KU as your 16 Ο. electrical supplier fall under your responsibility? 17 Yes, that's right. 18 Α. Okay. And who did you report to? 19 Ο, I report to the vice president of 20 21 operations and the president. 22 All right, sir. Who was the vice 0. 23 president of operations? 24 Α. Cristobal Fuentes. 25 Christopher [sic] Fuentes? Ο.

1 Α. Yes. 2 All right, sir. Going back to Q. 3 September of 2003, I take it that North American Stainless became unhappy with the rates it was being 4 charged by KU. Am I correct? 5 Yeah, that's -- that's right. 6 7 Okay.
