On September 27, 2004, Clark Energy Cooperative, Inc. ("Clark Energy") filed an application for approval of an agreement with Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") to change the electric territorial boundary at Woodland Industrial Park in Mt. Sterling, Kentucky.

The proposed changes will realign the electric boundary with property lines. Clark Energy filed an agreement signed by KU and Clark Energy describing the boundary changes. A subdivision map reflecting the boundary changes was filed and signed by KU and Clark Energy. No existing customer will be reassigned to a different electric supplier as a result of the proposed territorial boundary changes.

Based on the application and being advised, the Commission finds that the proposed boundary changes will prevent wasteful duplication of facilities, avoid unnecessary encumbering of the landscape, minimize disputes between KU and Clark Energy, and provide adequate and reasonable service to all affected areas.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the boundary changes as agreed upon by KU and Clark Energy at Woodland Industrial Park in Mt. Sterling, Kentucky are approved.
