<u>O R D E R</u>

On June 30, 2005, the Commission entered an Order in this case directing the Complainant to inform the Commission, within 10 days of the date of the Order, whether he had accepted Defendant's offer of satisfaction. The Order, mailed on June 30, 2005 to the address shown on the complaint,¹ was returned marked "undeliverable." On July 21, 2005, the Commission mailed to Complainant, via certified mail, another copy of the June 30, 2005 Order to the listed address for his business, Children's Garden. The Order was returned to the Commission marked "unclaimed." On August 15, 2005, the Commission mailed to Complainant, via certified mail, another solution, the Commission mailed to Complainant. The Order was returned to the Commission marked "unclaimed." On August 15, 2005, the Commission mailed to Complainant, via certified mail, another copy of the June 30, 2005 Order to the law firm shown on the complaint.² Receipt of the Order was

confirmed and, as of the date of this Order, no response has been filed with the Commission.

The Commission's Order of June 30, 2005 directed Complainant to inform the Commission, within 10 days of the date of the Order, of his acceptance or rejection of Defendant's apparent satisfaction of the complaint. No such response was received within the allowed time despite the Commission's attempts to serve Complainant with a copy of the June 30, 2005 Order. The Commission has made every reasonable effort to provide Complainant with a copy of the Order. Having received no response from Complainant, the Commission now finds that the complaint should be dismissed as satisfied.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this case is dismissed with prejudice as satisfied.
