FIRST DATA REQUEST OF COMMISSION STAFF
TO OWEN ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, INC.

Owen Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("Owen"), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, is to file with the Commission the original and five copies of the following information, with a copy to all parties of record. The information requested herein is due within 7 days of the date of this request. Each copy of the data requested should be placed in a bound volume with each item tabbed. When a number of sheets are required for an item, each sheet should be appropriately indexed, for example, Item 1(a), Sheet 2 of 6. Include with each response the name of the person who will be responsible for responding to questions relating to the information provided. Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. Where information herein has been previously provided, in the format requested herein, reference may be made to the specific location of said information in responding to this information request. When applicable, the information requested herein should be provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations, separately.

1. Refer to Owen's response to Item 5 of the Commission's Order dated December 13, 2004. Owen proposes no changes to Schedule III – Security Lights.

a. Explain why Owen does not propose to adjust the monthly charge for security lights to allow for the increased energy charges resulting from the fuel adjustment charge roll-in to base rates.

b. Provide the number of security lights Owen has in service for each of the following types:

- (1) Installed on existing pole.
- (2) One pole added.
- (3) Two poles added.
- (4) Three poles added.
- (5) Four poles added.

2. For each type of security light, provide the revised lighting rates with the fuel roll-in cost included.
