ORDER

On May 10, 2005, The Union Light, Heat and Power Company ("ULH&P") filed a motion requesting to reopen the procedural schedule in this proceeding to permit it to submit additional consumer research in support of its application. Included with the motion was a proposed procedural schedule for processing the remainder of this case, assuming the motion is granted. On May 19, 2005, ULH&P supplemented its May 10, 2005 filing by offering revisions to its proposed procedural schedule. On May 20, 2005, the Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, by and through his Office of Rate Intervention ("AG"), filed a response in which he objects to ULH&P's motion.

Having considered the motion and the AG's objection and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that ULH&P's motion to reopen the procedural schedule is reasonable and should be approved. However, we also find that the revised procedural schedule offered by ULH&P is overly compressed and should be modified in order to permit the AG and Commission Staff adequate time to conduct their review of the data ULH&P intends to file in support of its application.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. ULH&P's motion to reopen the procedural schedule is granted.

2. The procedural schedule in Appendix A to this Order shall be followed for the remainder of this proceeding.
