DATA REQUEST OF COMMISSION STAFF
TO GARRARD COUNTY WATER ASSOCIATION, INC.

Garrard County Water Association, Inc. (“Garrard Water”), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, is to file with the Commission the original and four copies of the following information, with a copy to all parties of record. The information requested herein is due 10 days from the date of this request. Include with each response the name of the person who will be responsible for responding to questions relating to the information provided. Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible.

1. In regard to the answer to complaint, page 2, No. 6, “or sponsoring a distribution line extension project to extend a distribution line to the edge of his property”:

a. If Danny Ray Adams agrees to “sponsor a distribution line extension project,” will the new distribution line be located in the same easement as the

proposed service line (through the easement that Calvin Vaughn has granted to Mr. Adams)?

b. If yes,

(1) What is the length of the proposed distribution line?

(2) What are the benefits to the utility of locating a distribution line in an easement as opposed to locating a customer's service line in the easement?

(3) What will the cost of this extension be to the utility?

(4) What will the cost be to the customer?

c. If no,

(1) Where will the distribution line extension be located?

(2) What is the length of the distribution line extension?

(3) What will the cost of this extension be to the utility?

(4) What will the cost be to the customer?

2. In regard to Mr. Adams' property:

a. Does Mr. Adams' property border any road (does it have any road frontage)?

b. If yes,

(1) Does that road have an existing distribution line?

(2) How far is the existing distribution line to the customer's property?

(3) What would be the required length of the service line?

(4) What will the cost of this proposal be to the utility?

(5) What will the cost be to the customer?

3. In regard to locating Mr. Adams' meter near the existing distribution line on Highway 1295 (either on Mr. Vaughn's property or on the highway right-of-way) and locating a service line in the easement granted by Mr. Vaughn,

- a. What would be the required length of the service line?
- b. What will the cost of this proposal be to the utility?
- c. What will the cost be to the customer?

4. a. As it stands right now, does the utility see any way for Mr. Adams to obtain water service other than purchasing additional land?

- b. If yes,
 - (1) What are the options?
 - (2) What will the cost of these options be to the utility?
 - (3) What will the cost be to the customer?
