ORDER

On January 4, 2005, Kentucky RSA #3 Cellular General Partnership ("RSA #3"), a Commercial Mobile Radio Service carrier, filed with the Commission a petition under 47 U.S.C. § 214(e)(2) seeking designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier ("ETC") to receive federal universal service support for service offered throughout its licensed service area in the state of Kentucky, including rural and non-rural areas.¹

The petition states that: (1) RSA #3 meets all the requirements for designation as an ETC to serve the designated areas in the state of Kentucky;² (2) RSA #3 requests designation throughout each of the designated areas within its service coverage;³ (3) In accordance with 47 U.S.C. § 214(e)(2), RSA #3 is entitled to be designated as an ETC in non-rural wirecenters;⁴ and (4) Designation of RSA #3 as an ETC for the designated areas served by a Rural Telephone Company in Kentucky will serve the public interest.⁵

The Commission seeks comment on RSA #3's petition from affected parties and the general public. The Commission will also set a procedural schedule for this matter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

 Comments on the application are due within 30 days of the date of this Order.

2. Any information requests to RSA #3 are due within 45 days of the date of this Order.

3. RSA #3 shall respond to any information requests within 60 days of the date of this Order.

4. Requests for a public hearing in this matter are due within 75 days of the date of this Order.

5. If no requests for a public hearing are made, parties may file any additional comments on the application and information requests for the Commission to consider within 90 days of the date of this Order.
