On December 12, 2005, East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. ("East Kentucky") filed a partial response to the information requested at the November 29, 2005 hearing and moved for an extension of time until December 22, 2005 to file the remaining information. As grounds for its motion, East Kentucky states that its staff must analyze various alternative transmission projects that may affect the manner in which it responds to the requests.

As there is no statutory deadline for completing this proceeding, and recognizing the importance of receiving thorough responses to the information requested, the Commission finds good cause to grant East Kentucky's motion.
